His success at the minor level led him to the Georgetown Jr. A Raiders, where he played for four seasons, averaging well over a point per game. His exceptional performance earned him multiple All-Star appearances and, ultimately, the retirement of his jersey by the organization—a testament to his impact on the team and community.

Following his junior career, Ryan took his talents to NCAA Division III Plattsburgh State University. During his four-year tenure at PSU, he continued his offensive dominance, averaging over a point per game while helping lead his team to an NCAA Final Four appearance and a SUNYAC Championship. His leadership qualities were evident, as he was named Assistant Captain and later Captain in his final two seasons. After his collegiate success, Ryan embarked on a professional career, playing in Finland for Division II Varkauk Eagles and Mestis' SaPKo, where he maintained his scoring prowess and leadership presence. He later returned to North America for his final pro season with the Richmond Renegades of the SPHL, tallying an impressive 65 points in 60 games. After retiring as a player, Ryan shifted his focus to coaching, eager to pass on his skills, knowledge, and love for the game.
